REGISTRATION POLICIES

Registrations are taken and confirmed, on a first-come, first-served basis according to receipt of full payment or purchase order. **Unpaid registrations without a purchase order will be canceled after 30 days. If you do not receive a confirmation within three weeks after sending full payment or purchase order, call (781) 449-4010 ext.101 or ext. 102.** Early bird registration is \$239 and only \$219 for *Learning & the Brain* Society members through Feb. 11, 2011. General conference registration is \$279 per person and only \$259 if you are a *Learning & the Brain* Society member, from Feb. 12, 2011 through March 25, 2011. After March 25, 2011, late registration will be \$289 per person or \$269 if you are a Society member. A \$25 administrative fee will be added for on-site registration at the conference. Groups of five or more may register at \$199 per person through February 11, 2011 and \$239 a person after February 11, 2011, if registering together with payment or purchase order.

SUBSTITUTIONS, CANCELLATIONS AND WAIT LIST

Substitutions are permissible up to seven days before the conference, but you must notify PIRI in writing by fax or mail. Cancellations must be requested no later than March 25, 2011. No cancellations can be accepted after March 25, 2011. Because cancellations incur substantial administrative costs, we regret that it is necessary to charge a cancellation fee of \$45 per person if before Feb. 11, 2011 or \$95 per person if you cancel after Feb. 11, 2011, but before March 25, 2011.
